Community Involvement/Support

- INPUT INTO FOREST PLANS
- HOLDING AGENCIES ACCOUNTABLE FOR ACCOMPLISHING ACTIVITIES IN THE FOREST PLAN
- LOOKING ACROSS ALL OWNERSHIPS & IDENTIFYING OPPORTUNITIES TO ENHANCE THE COMMUNITY'S ECONOMIC VIABILITY
- DEVELOPING PARTNERSHIPS/TEAMS TO WORK ON SPECIFIC ISSUES

- IDENTIFYING POTENTIAL PROBLEMS & ADDRESSING THEM:
 - CORPORATE LAND SALES
 - COMPANY CLOSING IT'S DOORS

- LOCAL GOVERNMENT WORKING WITH STATE AND FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO FIND SOLUTIONS TO SPECIFIC ISSUES/PROBLEMS
